REVIEW OF THE SEYCHELLES LICENSING ACT AND REGULATIONS

The Republic of Seychelles has received financing from The African Development Bank's Fund for African Private Sector Assistance (FAPA) toward the cost of implementing the Seychelles micro, small and medium enterprises (MSME) Development Project, and intends to apply part of the financing received to payments under the contract for the **Review of the Seychelles Licensing Act and Regulations**.

The consultancy services under this assignment includes the reviewing and the development of a modern licensing regime for the Republic Of Seychelles to be reviewed by key stakeholders and finally approved by the Government of Seychelles. The assignment should:

- a. Identify the Act limitations in terms of licensing, enforcement, adequacy of current fees and information sharing with other authorities,
- b. Review the License Conditions of all Licensable activities in Seychelles and propose amendments with the aim of facilitation of the ease of doing business within the current business environment.

The Ministry of Investment, Industry and Entrepreneurship Development (MIIED) now invites eligible individual consultants to indicate their interest in providing the required services for a period of 30 days. Interested consultants must provide information showing clearly that they are qualified to undertake this assignment (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, evidence of appropriate skills, etc.).

The method of selection shall be an Individual Consultant (IC). The eligibility criteria, establishment of the short list and the selection procedure shall be in conformity with the African Development Bank's **"Rules and Procedures for Use of Consultants"**, dated October 2015.
